



**PGY – 1 Graduation Requirements  
Pharmacy Residents**

<b>Residency Requirement</b>
1. Complete Orientation Checklist
2. Licensed > 80% of the residency year (by October 1st)
3. Successful completion of all learning experiences <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Nine (9) required learning experiences + Orientation</li> <li>b. One elective experience</li> <li>c. Longitudinal learning experiences (Teaching &amp; Education, Pharmacy Practice, Research, Informatics)</li> </ul>
4. Complete a case report, MUE, or retrospective QI project, presented at a professional meeting (RISHP, ASHP Clinical Midyear, Eastern States)
<b>5. Complete one longitudinal research project</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li><b>a. Obtain IRB approval</b></li> <li><b>b. Conduct research</b></li> <li><b>c. Present results at a peer reviewed meeting (Eastern States)</b></li> <li><b>d. Submit acceptable manuscript (reviewed by preceptor)</b></li> </ul>
6. Certification in Anticoagulation and ACLS
7. Achieve ≥ 80% of all residency goals and objectives as Achieved for Residency (ACHR) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. All Needs Improvement (NI) have been resolved as Satisfactory Progress (SP) or Achieved (ACH)</li> </ul>
8. Complete all evaluations in Pharmacademic
9. Complete teaching certificate through University of Rhode Island
